Course Applicability Major Change Requests	The Automated Change of Major process launched last month on 2/11 and yesterday, March 3rd, was the major change deadline for Spring 2024. With Spring enrollment underway through the end of the term and with Fall enrollment beginning on April 15th, an exception process has been established for students impacted by course applicability outside the Automated Major Change deadlines. Financial Aid will contact students impacted via email and provide a link to the form for each campus.
