Priority Registration for Fall Upcoming	Priority registration for Fall 2024 began April 15th for Priority 0 and continues through open registration starting May 14th. Visit the Priority Registration and Enrollment Dates page for a complete listing of the priority registration dates.
Payment Due Date & Autodrop for Summer 2024	The payment deadline for students enrolling on or before June 10th for Summer 2024 is Monday, May 27th. The autodrop will be scheduled overnight the morning of Tuesday, May 28th. For more information see the Spring 2024 Academic Calendar .
Military Credit - Credit for Prior Learning Update	We've achieved a major milestone in advancing Credit for Prior Learning by establishing a tailored process for evaluating military transcripts of our veteran students. Starting May 6, veterans can conveniently request Credit for Prior Learning through a user-friendly web form accessible on each college's website. This request and transcript will be routed to the appropriate academic departments for review. Military courses approved for credit will be posted to the student's transcript and used to fulfill degree and certificate requirements.
Academic Renewal for AB705	<p>We're happy to announce that new exceptions in Academic Renewal processes at the recommendation of the District Academic Senate have been approved in an update to R-7252 to aid students in obtaining academic renewal in courses no longer offered as a result of AB705 implementation once a transfer level course in the same sequence has been passed.</p> <p>These changes will allow for a student who, for example, did not pass a MATH 100 course that is no longer offered as a result of AB705 to obtain renewal immediately upon completing the transfer-level course in the sequence without having to complete additional units, wait additional time, or factor these units in to the overall number of units that can be renewed.</p> <p>Admissions and IT are working on updating the petitions available to students in eServices and we expect to have updates soon on when this change will go live in eServices. In the meantime, A&R will automatically apply these exceptions when academic renewal is requested for qualifying courses.</p>
Change to Summer/Fall CCCApply Timeline	For many years, the summer/fall application process opened on February 1st of each year. In 2018, the opening date of the application changed to October 1st of each year. While the goal was to align with the UC/CSU application timeline (October 1-November 30), this change has resulted in greater complexity and challenges in A&R and confusion for students (who inadvertently apply for the wrong term when intending to enroll in spring classes because both applications for current year and new year are open at the same time). At the recommendation of the A&R Supervisors, and with the support of college VPSS's, Outreach Deans, and the DESSC, the

	<p>recommendation was approved to restore the February 1st release date for the summer/fall application. DOIT is currently assessing capacity to implement the change. The goal is to have this in place for summer/fall 2025 application cycle. More information will be forthcoming as details are finalized.</p>
<p>A&R Redesign Unified Petitions and Improvements</p>	<p>Through the collaborative A&R Redesign, unified A&R petitions have been developed and are being deployed in coordination with IT to ensure a universal petition experience with the first four being released this month. Through this process, petition language has been streamlined to make sure the purpose of the form, conditions for approval, potential outcomes and processing timelines are shared upfront using accessible language. We have also streamlined workflows and improved routing to minimize unnecessary steps and eliminate processing bottlenecks. Updated petitions were released as follows:</p> <p>4/2/2024 – Repeat Petition</p> <p>4/16/2024 – Late Add Petition, Exceed Unit Petition, Late Drop Petition</p> <p>We expect additional petitions to be updated mid-May including the Academic Renewal Petition, Time-Conflict Petition, and the Appeal for Loss of Priority / CCPG Eligibility.</p>
<p>Graduation Petition Processing Updates</p>	<p>Evaluators districtwide have completed processing (evaluating and posting where applicable) 3,688 graduating petitions for Fall 2023.</p> <p>Our evaluators have also been entering graduation petition data and conducting initial evaluations on the 6,489 graduation petitions submitted for Spring 2024. Once Spring grades are assigned on May 23rd, evaluators will prioritize ADT's (CSU requires certification by June 30th) and other special programs with external deadlines ahead of the state requiring all 2023-2024 awards to be posted by September 15th.</p>
<p>Major Change Updates</p>	<p>The Automated Change of Major process launched on February 11th and since that time 3,483 automated major changes have been initiated through April 18th.</p> <p>The deadline to use the automated process to change a Spring major was March 3rd; major changes submitted after that through the automated process will apply to Summer and Fall. An exception process is available for students who need to change a major in a current or future term outside of the automated window in order to mitigate course applicability issues. To date, the campuses have received 70 requests to change majors via the exception process.</p>
