Updates to Residency Requirements for Associate Degrees Effective Fall 2023	Associate degrees, both local and transfer, require students to complete twelve units in residence within the Los Rios Community College District. Residency requirements for associate degrees were updated statewide to reflect twelve units districtwide over twelve units at a specific college via a title 5 update that became effective in November 2023. Los Rios formally adopted these changes in regulation in December 2024. From this point forward, Los Rios evaluators will consider residency as twelve units districtwide retroactively from Fall 2023 to present. Evaluators at each campus have ensured that these requirements have been retroactively applied to any student who had not met the residency requirement for the campus, but did meet the expanded residency requirement, from Fall 2023 forward have had their graduation petitions reevaluated and degrees awarded where applicable.
Los Rios Partners With AACRAO to Improve International Student Experience	Los Rios has contracted with the American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (AACRAO) to align practices on international student admissions and produce training materials to keep the colleges in alignment and improve onboarding of new staff in this area. Importantly, this work will ensure a consistent high quality experience at each of our college International Student offices. AACRAO was on site last week to meet with staff, faculty and others who work directly with international students, and engaged a panel of international students to describe their experiences to better inform this process.
Common Course Numbering Update	Los Rios is implementing its first phase of the Common Course Numbering transition in Fall 2025. Math and English placements have been updated to reflect the new course numbers and students with existing education plans will also see the new course numbers in their iSEPs. Cal-GETC Update	Beginning Fall 2025, the Cal-GETC general education pattern replaces the IGETC and CSU Breadth general education patterns for students with catalog rights beginning in Fall 2025. Students with older catalog rights can also opt for Cal-GETC or continue with their current GE pattern. A new local general education pattern has also been implemented beginning Fall 2025. Transfer Evaluation Service

The Transfer Evaluation Service (TES) is now being used by Admissions & Records to track and process course substitution and equivalency requests for credit earned outside of Los Rios. TES provides faculty who review these requests a side-by-side comparison of course descriptions and additional documentation provided by the student. TES will reduce repetitive reviews by faculty and create a repository of approved courses as approved by faculty.
