1. CALL TO ORDER

Chancellor King called the Zoom Conference meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

2. FINALIZE AGENDA & MINUTES OF MEETINGS

The October 26, 2020 meeting agenda and minutes of the October 12, 2020 meeting were approved by consensus.

3. PROPOSED REVISIONS TO R-P-7137 CREDIT FOR PRIOR LEARNING

Interim General Counsel Jake Knapp presented the proposed revisions to Policy 7137: Credit for Prior Learning to the Chancellor's Cabinet. The more-detailed regulation will be developed and presented to Cabinet at a later date. The goal is to have both the policy and regulation implemented by the end of December.

4. ARC PRESIDENT SEARCH UPDATE

Chancellor King provided an update on the ARC President Search. The Impression Group sessions are scheduled for this Friday, and reference checking will occur next week.

5. PLANNING FOR 2021

Chancellor King led a discussion regarding planning for 2021 that primarily focused on ways to potentially streamline Spring Convocation given our virtual/remote environment and the advantage of getting groups together that would have been logistically challenging face-to-face. The Academic Senate leaders provided feedback and recommendations on the best approach to incorporate a districtwide convocation message into the college programs.

6. FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS AND MEETING SCHEDULE

Belinda Lum asked about resources for students that may be needed depending on the outcome of the November 3 election. Chancellor King responded that a draft communication is being prepared but cautioned that it's a hard needle to thread regarding messaging.

Draft Credit for Prior Learning LRCCD Board Policy

POLICY

Instructional Program

Credit for Prior Learning **P-7137**

Instructional Arrangements

1.0 Credit for Prior Learning

- 1.1 Credit for prior learning is credit awarded for validated college-level skills and knowledge gained outside of a college classroom including, but not limited to, military training, industry training, state/federal government training, apprenticeships, internships, work-based learning or other industry-based experiential learning, validated volunteer and civic activities (ESS 20-300-001).

2.0 Procedures

- 2.1 Procedures for students to attain credit for prior learning shall include, but not be limited to, evaluation of student-created portfolios, evaluation of industry-recognized credential documentation and standardized exams, credit by examination, college level examination program (CLEP), college board advanced placement exam, evaluation of Joint Services Transcripts, (CCR, Title 5, §55050(a)).

3.0 Policy Review and Reporting

- 3.1 This policy shall be reviewed every three years by the LRCCD board of trustees (CCR, Title 5, §55050(I)).
- 3.2 The LRCCD Board of Trustees shall report disaggregated data by gender and race/ethnicity, the number of students who received credit for prior learning, the number of credits awarded per student, retention and persistence rates of students earning credit for prior learning, completion data (for certificate, degree and transfer) for students earning credit for prior learning, and qualitative assessments by students of the policies and procedures (CCR, Title 5, §55050(I)).
