#### **1. CALL TO ORDER**

Chancellor King called the Zoom Conference meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

President Michael Gutierrez took a moment to recognize two members the Sacramento City College campus community recently lost to COVID, Ruben Ruiz and Craig Hart, both classified professionals.

#### **2. FINALIZE AGENDA & MINUTES OF MEETINGS**

The February 1, 2021 meeting agenda and minutes of the January 25, 2021 meeting were approved by consensus.

#### **3. INITIAL REPORT OF THE REOPENING PLANNING TEAM**

The Reopening Planning Team, Vice Presidents Frank Kobayashi (ARC), Monica Pactol (FLC), Teresa Tena (CRC) and Davin Brown (SCC), joined the Cabinet meeting to answer questions about the initial draft of the report that was shared with Chancellor's Cabinet on Thursday, January 28.

Constituent leaders shared feedback, questions and recommendations they have received from their respective employee groups about the communication process and the report itself. The timeline for publishing the fall schedule, and the various implications that potentially moving the schedule release dates could have on student services, were also discussed.

Deputy Chancellor Nye confirmed that Summer will be on online with the 15 COVID-related programs on-ground again. He also discussed the specific list of impossible-to-convert courses that may be offered on-ground with the necessary safety protocols in place, and Cabinet expressed support for this approach.

Chancellor King clarified that while Chancellor's Cabinet will serve as the steering committee for participatory governance issues that need to be considered in the reopening plan, collective bargaining matters will not be negotiated by this body.

The feedback received through the web link on the draft form will be provided to Cabinet.
