1. CALL TO ORDER

Chancellor King called the Zoom Conference meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

2. FINALIZE AGENDA & MINUTES OF MEETINGS

The October 25, 2021 meeting agenda and the September 27, 2021 minutes were approved.

3. ACCREDITATION/STRATEGIC PLANNING

Deputy Chancellor Nye provided an update on the status of our accreditation process timelines. The ISERs will be presented to the Board of Trustees on November 10. After Board approval, the college and district teams will begin meeting in February. The focused site visit by the reviewing teams is scheduled for the week of October 10, 2022. Each college provided an update on their respective accreditation activities and review of the strategic planning goals as they are being vetted through their participatory governance processes, noting that the intent of this updated process is to create opportunity for more feedback by evaluating the strategic plan yearly to make sure we're making progress towards our strategic goals, rather than waiting five years until the next review of the strategic plan.

4. ALIGNED REDESIGN OF STUDENT SERVICES

Deputy Chancellor Nye announced that Sonia Ortiz-Mercado will be serving as the District's Interim Associate Vice Chancellor of Educational Services and Student Success. With Sonia's expertise, the redesign of student services has been moved under their direction. Sonia provided an update on the redesign, clarifying that no changes have been made yet, and that the process will be collaborative and data informed.

Interim Associate Vice President of Student Resources, Financial Aid Yolanda Garcia and Interim Associate Vice President of Student Resources, Admissions and Records Parrish Geary provided a detailed overview of the goals and guiding principles of the redesign, as well as examples of ways they believe more alignment across the colleges will benefit our students and staff while improving processes and efficiencies. The timeline for the project was also presented. The consultants are in the process of beginning the early stages of their work, with interviewing commencing the week of November 8. Each college provided their feedback and input on the opportunities to engage in the process since last spring. It was acknowledged that a physical presence of admissions and financial aid staff will still be needed on the college campuses. All constituent representatives had an opportunity to provide feedback.
