CHANCELLOR'S CABINET MEETING Minutes Monday, December 11, 2023 Board Room 3:00pm

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chancellor King called the meeting to order at 3:00pm.

2. FINALIZE AGENDA & MINUTES OF MEETINGS

The November 27, 2023 minutes and December 11, 2023 agenda were approved.

3. PROPOSED REVISIONS TO R-7137: CREDIT FOR PRIOR LEARNING

Chief Counsel Knapp presented the proposed revisions to R-7137, Credit for Prior Learning to Cabinet. The proposed revisions were approved by consensus and the regulation will be updated online.

4. STATE BUDGET UPDATE

Executive Vice Chancellor Rodriguez provided a high-level overview of the state budget process for the benefit of newer Cabinet members. He then went through the LAO's analysis of the 2024-25 state budget, including the prior, current fiscal year and the upcoming budget years. The current projection is a 10% reduction over the next two years. Executive Vice Chancellor Rodriguez also discussed the Department of Finance's analysis, which is more optimistic than the LAO opinion. The Governor's proposed budget will be released around January 10. Members of Cabinet discussed a variety of budget and funding-related topics that could have potential impacts on the statewide system and Los Rios.

*During all terms, classes are offered in additional formats to enhance student opportunity: 1st and 2nd eight week sessions; 1st, 2nd and 3rd five week sessions; as well as weekend only classes. Examples might include four, five, six and eight week sessions and weekend courses, as well as other session lengths.

NOTE: Classes may be scheduled on all days during the Summer term including Friday through Sunday; the count of days, though, is Monday-Thursday only as those are the primary days when instruction is offered. Both the Fall and Spring terms have scheduled instructional days, such as Saturdays, that are not included in the number of days shown above. Those additional days ensure the district is in compliance with the requirements of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, sections 58120 and 58142.
