Prison and Reentry Education Program Committee Request

To meet the unique academic needs of students who are currently or formerly incarcerated, in the fall of 2019, a group of faculty (Georgine Hodgkinson, Kalinda Jones, and Nich Miller) and Los Rios' Director of Prison Re-entry and Education Progam (Mari Peshon), began meeting. This group became an Ad Hoc Committee of the District Academic Senate in the spring of 2020. Since that time, the group has met bi-weekly. The group has grown and in order to align with recent legislation (AB417 & SB416), we are proposing a permanent structure for the committee. We are requesting that the District Academic Senate provide us feedback and support for the attached committee structure.
