8. Updates from the District – Jamey

- English Prerequisite Checker had a small glitch that is now fixed.
- NFN – CRC wants to have older programs CCCCO approved and needs NFN approval. Those programs will not require the usual paperwork, but they will be re-approved to get new approval dates. If you have existing CTE programs that need this, too, we can deal with them more efficiently.
- Dual Enrollment group is working on a template. CCCCO legal memo is challenging to meet. Example: if a dual enrollment course at a high school has another section fill with a waitlist, CCCCO requires you to pull it. That can't happen. Issues with faculty preference, too.

9. DAS Report – Dan

- DAS next Tuesday: LMS workgroup recommendation, update on dual enrollment, proposal for increased reassigned time for leadership including DCCC chair.

10. SAG Report – Bill

- a. Location of C-ID information on CORs for non-transfer courses:
C-ID is now being used for non-transfer-level courses, but Phil has C-ID requests and approvals showing up in the *Relationship to Transfer Institutions* section of CORs, which is not displayed for below-transfer courses. Where would we like him to put it? (Consensus: create a new C-ID section for it). Bill will notify Phil.
- b. Location of units-to-hours calculation information:
New PCAH states out-of-class student learning hours should be shown explicitly on the COR to make unit calculation clearer. Where would we like to have it?
Mary – can we add it to the basic course information at the top? Jamey – as long as it doesn't go to PeopleSoft. Dan – don't call it "homework"; use their language "out of class hours." Bill will notify Phil.

11. Music Courses Families

- a. MUIVI families for applied music courses – Joe
Applied music is done in different ways at each college, some with repeatable courses and others with leveled non-repeatable courses. We came up with a plan that puts repeatable and leveled courses in families that makes sense to the four colleges.

- a. New DCCC Chair – CRC's turn. Michael Lawlor has volunteered.

Topics vs. Experimental courses – why do we have topics courses if they are not repeatable? How are they different than experimental courses? Do we need them any more?

Bill and Dyan have recently had developers withdraw board approved curriculum that was at CCCCO status. Should we direct SAG to prioritize fixing this? (Consensus: Yes.) Bill will notify Phil.
