- I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 2:35 PM.
- II. Approval of Agenda: The agenda was approved by consent.

- V. Competency Committee Reports
 - A. Reading Competency (Chair: Tracy Rauschkolb, FLC): CRC SOC 305, ENGRD 311 under review
 - B. Math Competency (Chair: Jean Vrechek, Joseph Steever, SCC): None. A general discussion ensued about CSUS new math competency courses being written in light of the Executive Order. Currently Los Rios aligns with CSUS, but it's possible that more courses will meet CSUS's quantitative reasoning requirements. New courses at CSUS could be developed at Los Rios.

 - A. Families Note: missing ADAPT families. There may be former language exempting ADAPT courses from families. We're gradually rolling-out enrollment families in PE.

 (All Courses/Programs are organized by college and listed at the end of this agenda.)

 CRC: Motion to approve all but HMONG 401: Yang/Pease MSP

HMONG 401: DCCC recommended modifying the justification to suggest a broader audience after clarifying the course's target audience and removing "low novice level" from the description. If a heritage speakers' course, renumber the course to 413. HMONG 401 was tabled.

VPIs meet to achieve consensus. If there were any concerns, then the proposal would go to an informational meeting, consensus, and/or official vote if needed. Once approved, there will be a 2 year window to develop, with a warning at 1.5 years. Some discussion points follow:

- Could concerns be sent through the local curriculum committee first before being sent to the PPC for further discussion?
