- X. Discussion Items:
 - A. Student choice of any of the three GE patterns (Lynn)
 - a. Lynn reported that there are 46 schools that allow students to choose any of the three GE patterns, and two that do not. Allowing students to choose their own GE pattern is less confusing. Students will still have to complete local graduation requirements. It's in the PCAH on page 84. Allowing choice to students will help overall because it will provide the students with more options. Lynn will put together proposed language for our next meeting. Discussion to go to Academic Senate.
 - B. A place to list online programs (Renee): Where is it listed in our catalog or website "full online programs/classes?" The conversation is beginning with the College Presidents and the Academic Senate according to Alisa Shubb. There is no "Los Rios Online."
 - C. C minus issues (Shannon): There is a disparity between students coming here with a C-from another institution that deems it passing, and we don't, and it is different from campus to campus within Los Rios. AOs and evaluators are the ones making the interpretation. It is super subjective and open to interpretation. It was agreed that we may need more language clarifying the issue in Board Policy. Shannon Gilley and Dyan Pease agreed to take a look at the issue.
 - D. Catalog year start date: This is an issue because currently the new year starts with summer session but new articulations do not take effect until fall. Tammy Montgomery agreed to take the issue to the VPI discussion table this next month.
 - E. Advisories and requisites in a post AB-705 world (Lynn): This goes back to the discussion in December with Jamey Nye's argument about pre-requisites and advisories. Tammy Montgomery agreed to take this issue to the AB705 implementation group for discussion.

- F. In 298 and 498 Work Experience courses the board policy states that students can earn units in 0.5 increments. However, in Socrates these courses are listed as being 1 4 units. Work Experience would like Socrates to say 0.5 4 units. Theresa Milan is currently working on the issue.
- G. Non-Credit (Renee) There is no interest in pursuing non-credit courses according to Tammy Montgomery. However, it was agreed that Alisa will see if there is interest at the District Academic Senate regarding the use of non-credit.
