DE Modality College/Facility Emergency Closure

Up to 100% of During a college / facility emergency closure this course may be offered via distance education when needed during college/facility closure emergencies. When taught online during college/facility closure emergencies the course shall include regular and effective contact as required by Title 5 and adhere to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act. Course outcomes will be met by providing synchronous or asynchronous material using the learning management system, including readings, simulations, videos, etc. Assessments may be administered, and assignments and projects may be collected and evaluated via the learning management system.

To teach this course online outside of a college/facilities emergency closure emergency, regular distance education curriculum approval must be granted separately from this college/facility emergency closure emergency addendum.
