XI. Discussion Items

A. Similar / Cross-listed courses in the District and Degree Planner
Lisa Roberts-Law: Different designators are sometimes used at different colleges
for the same course. DP is not recognizing this because of how it is entered in
Peoplesoft.

Question: Who decides what is listed as equivalent in Peoplesoft? Discussion: This is an Instruction Office task. Isn't this a 10+1 issue? This highlights the GE alignment issues. Is there a need for a more formal process to program this into Peoplesoft? We must be careful about what is "equivalent" across the district. Use the word "comparable"? Do we need a field in Socrates? We will bring this up at SAG. We need a list of current course equivalencies. A crystal report does exist for this.

Action: This topic will be brought to DAS.

- B. Student discussion on asynchronous STEM and Performing Arts classes Allison S. Students are advocating for more asynchronous online courses after we are back on campus.
 - Jenn G. There are some concerns about how Performing Arts courses are being delivered online.
- C. Proposal to remove local Credit by Exam unit/residency requirement This requirement is not currently in our Board Policy and Regs. Title 5 is silent on this.
 - Recommendation from DCCC to DAS: Ask each local Senate to discuss removing this language from the catalog. (Eric will send all Curriculum Chairs information about this topic to share with local Senates.)
- D. Anti-racism and equity in curriculum: Ongoing discussion on how each campus is addressing or plans to address the topic. Inviting authentic student engagement. *Skipped because of time constraints.*
- E. Proposal to review and consider amending Board Regulation 3412 to references to the Reading Competency Committee.
 - Because of recent changes in how students meet Reading Competency this committee will no longer need to review courses. Reading Competency is now met by completing a degree or a GE pattern, it is no longer course based.
