 - b. HIST 310/311 Catalog status effective date? Now ready for catalog status with 6/1/21 effective date
 - c. Ready: ENGRD 312, HSER 498, WELD 298. These need to be cataloged by chairs as soon as possible.

- VIII. Updates from the District
 - A. Music Convergence (T. Powell): Committee reconvened and resolved all of the issues and concerns. April 6th they will reconvene one last time.
 - B. PPC Process changes (Attachment 5)
 - i. Template for a new program proposal (T. Powell): **Update to PPC process** and creation of a submission form that is web accessible for faculty to complete.
 - IX. DAS Report E. Wada reported that C- proposal went through 2 readings at DAS we will soon send to Board for approval.

X. SAG Report

- A. Area F in Socrates update: what was previously in Area F is now "Area U"
- B. Changes to the DE field to meet Title 5 requirements (Attachment 6)
 - i. B. Noel reported on current draft language that is still available for review; a new updated draft version has been created that includes edits recommended by reviewers across the District. Further conversations should continue to develop course-level changes for accessibility as it's being delivered. DE coordinators would like to continue to be involved in conversations on this topic. K. Knudson suggested looking at how campuses have been addressing these issues in the CORs (regular effective contact and the American Disability Act). Suggestion to include ADA expertise whether from an addition member, or additional education/training for current DE coordinators. Suggestion to review this document again at the next meeting.
- C. Change the new designator form to include catalog department requests (Attachment 7)
 - i. No current process to assign a new program to a new catalog department in Socrates. Committee suggests revising form to include additional fields and further edits to provide further guidance for submissions by faculty.

XI. Discussion Items

- A. Similar / Cross-listed courses in the District and Degree Planner (Attachment 8)
 - i. Concerns on when students take courses among the different campuses that are not considered equivalent. Meaningful discussion needs to continue on what "similar" means with courses across the District. T. Powell will generate potential course criteria that signifies equivalency across the District. Report to be shared with local Depts to include equivalency numbers by C. Thornton.
- B. Proposal to remove local Credit by Exam unit/residency requirement (Attachment 9)
 - i. Supported by DAS. Next step is to operationalize this requirement. E. Wada and J. Oliver provided draft language for campuses.
- C. Local GE Area IIb approvals: Review Board Policy 7241 and discuss ways to clarify reasons for denials. (Attachment 10)
 - i. Concern for courses that are being denied for this area; request is for more clarification and justification on why courses are denied.
- D. CPL Guidance and local implementation (brief update discuss next steps)
 - Some additional training may be held over the summer. This topic will need to continue in the Fall 21 semester.
- E. Catalog start date change to fall
 - i. Need to have further discussion on how this can be achieved within the next year. R. Medina did not find this as a policy and regulations. Not clear

if this can be a decision at the administrative-level. T. Powell suggested the creation of a Task Force with Student Services representation.

- F. Anti-racism and equity in curriculum: Ongoing discussion on how each campus is addressing or plans to address the topic. Inviting authentic student engagement.
- G. GE alignment project: Update on progress, and identify next steps
