 - DAS approved by acclimation the ES Council's proposal to create Ethnic Studies departments at all colleges.
 - A resolution about class size was passed. A group will be formed to investigate class size issues.
 - Degree Audit was discussed. More information can be found in item XI.A. in the minutes.
- X. SAG Report
 - Dennis Holden is retiring. He will be missed.
 - The Course Classification field, which appears only in the developer view, was discussed. It is unclear why that field is needed for credit courses.
 - The issue with course deletions not displaying correctly may have been resolved.

 - DAS has requested that Degree Planner not be used for student advising at this time to avoid confusion about articulation differences in shared courses.
 - Perhaps DCCC can define "similar" courses for advising purposes. So far, the potential elements are name, number, CSU GE breadth, IGETC, Local GE, C-ID, and perhaps prerequisites and major prep articulation. This issue causes serious issues with our transfer students.
