Written report from Kevin Pipkin, Faculty Chair:

Socrates Advisory Group 09/16/21 Meeting

Over the summer the Online Grading System (OGS) was included into the varied list of Los Rios Apps (such as Canvas.) One place to Login to get to it all.

The new Area F (Ethnic Studies) GE pattern area is now included within Socrates course outlines.

The old Area F (US History) is now moved into an Area "U" heading in Socrates.

There is a Socrates Report that shows all courses approved for the different CSU GE areas.

XII. Discussion Items

- A. DE Addendum applicability when not under emergency closure (Medina)
 - ECA will cover shift to DE if needed should a class need to quarantine due to an exposure when the institution is not under the ECA in a broad sense.

- B. Create a local definition of co-requisites (Noel)
 - i. Some co-requisites must be taken concurrently with other course (i.e. English or Math courses with corequisite support courses).
 - 1. This can be problematic if a student passes the support course but fails the parent course (or vice versa)
 - ii. Perhaps a need for a mechanism in SOCRATES to define whether a co-requisite must be taken concurrently or can be taken previously as well.
 - iii. Possibly use schedule notes as an interim fix to better address how co-requisites will be utilized
 - iv. CRC will continue local discussions and bring a proposal back to DCCC in the future.
- C. Student choice of any of the three GE patterns
 - i. AB 928 seeks to create a unified GE pattern for CSU, UC, and CCC systems
 - Main point of contention seems to be 1 unit of Physical Education requirement that is part of local GE requirement and not part of CSU or IGETC patterns.
 - iii. Committee agrees to wait to see the fate of AB 928 before taking further action.
