Recommendations from the Catalog Effective Date Workgroup

- The 2022-2023 catalog should be 6/1/22 to 7/31/23 with addendums for 8/1/22 and 1/1/23 (assuming ability to create within Socrates). The 8/1/22 addendum would have specific guidelines to ensure catalog rights issues did not occur.
- Subsequent catalogs would have an effective date of 8/1/XX to 7/31/XX
- The Curriculum Committees and Instruction Office Teams work groups should develop draft guidelines for what should be allowed to have an 8/1/23 effective date. An initial recommendation was to limit to courses and disallow programs.
- Board Regulation 1112 should be reviewed to determine if changes are necessary.
- Updates/revisions to Map Maker, Degree Audit and Degree Planner should be synchronized to ensure consistency on the website and in the Academic Plan Tables/Degree Planner.
