A. Adoption of Findings Related to Public Meetings Pursuant to AB 361: "The state of emergency continues to directly impact the ability of members to meet safely in person."

Scott Crosier made the motion to extend and approve the vote to carry through the next meeting instead of the next 30 days. Carlos Lopez made the 2nd motion. It was approved unanimously.

IX. Updates from the District

T. Montgomery reported about Academic Renewal Regulation update- This allows students to be eligible immediately for academic renewal if students successfully complete the transfer-level English or Math course with a C or better. Because we no longer have the developmental courses preceding the transfer-level courses, this poses a problem for students if they do not

pass those. Tammy reports that the language has been developed but not shared with the DAS. She is waiting for the language to be released to her for approval.

Also, Tammy reported on the PPC- the list of programs listed for approval are available for viewing.

Finally, Tammy noted that we should have workgroups developed on both AB1111 and CALGETC, AB928. Tammy believes we should have a member on a working group, one member from each of the four colleges ideally. At the first meeting of Sp 2023, we should have names of those who want to serve on these work groups.

X. DAS Report

Scott Crosier reported that based on the recommendation by the Dist. Ed. Tech, the Dist. might no longer be using online tools for test proctoring. Thus, assessment for DE courses needs to be considered. Maybe students need to come to campus for test-taking. Renee asks if students will actually need to come to campus to take tests. Scott says the Senate will look into what we are saying specifically in light of Ed Tech's recommendation with online assessment.

XII. Discussion Items

- A. Coordinating & Expediting Collaboration Requests
 Rene asked to add this. Her experience is that faculty don't really understand the
 process or what happens once they sign off. In addition, she is concerned about
 the speed of one college moving these requests too fast. Brian from CRC agrees
 that it is not smooth or clear.
- B. Public Facing Course and Program Outlines
 Our AO's share these with transfer partners, but we don't need to share the
 entire COR, so Phil is working on simply sharing link for live version of these.
 Shannon (the SCC AO) suggests that if anyone wants a request of COR from the
 public, contact AO to do this.
- C. Preparing for the new Ethnic Studies degree requirement Rene asks for this discussion item. The new Ethnic Studies requirement for CCC will match CSU and UCs. We need to change our policies and regs now to get them to align.
- D. Workgroups for AB 928 (CalGETC) & AB 1111 (Common Course Numbering) This was already addressed by Tammy earlier in the meeting.
- E. Courses with Multiple Topic Blocks
 This was discussed in SAG, and we discussed in this meeting. However, the
 committee ultimately decided to not touch them in Socrates now. That is, we
 will leave them be. Brian Noel said that designators have 294 and 494 Topics
 courses. These would all be affected by a change to Topic Blocks.
- F. Cataloguing existing courses mid-year
 This should be a local decision by the college Instructional Office and local
 curriculum chairs to determine correct dates.

• Renee proposes that her college is discussing how to make the AO position more permanent. Right now it is release time, not a dedicated position. There should be more support time put into this position.
