### **Welcome & Announcements**

The zoom meeting was called to order at 3:00p. and the committee was welcomed by the faculty co-chair.

### **Approval of Agenda and April Notes:**

The agenda for the day was approved.

### **Informational Updates:**

- Demo and Feedback on New OGS (Online Grading System) Features – staff from DOIT presented information on the new features related to (1) the ability to pull grades from Canvas into the OGS; and (2) the ability to add a date to a roster when a student is added. A demonstration in OGS was presented where each student’s add date is noted, and the ability to “Load Canvas Scores” now appears where grades are posted into the system as well as the ability to “Assign Letter Grades” (based upon instructor set percentages) to eliminate the double data entry now required for posting student grades. It was noted that students not in the OGS but listed in Canvas’ roster would get a dashed line/no grade; and students listed in Canvas but not “officially” fully enrolled would not be automatically added to the OGS, and the faculty would need to do a late add. The ability to capture “Incompletes” within the OGS and assign a deadline by which they need to be resolved would be a desired future addition to this process. It was noted that once this new process is implemented, it will improve accuracy and save time by not having to double-enter

student's grades and any future ideas related to the enhancement of the process could be put on Ed Tech agenda and discussed. It was suggested that after the DAS reviews the recommendation and no major concerns are expressed that the tool be enabled for faculty use if desired.

- Approval Process for LTIs with AI Features – DOIT received a faculty request through Service Central to install an LTI entitled MyEssayFeedback which has some AI features. The request has gone through the local campus-based coordinators, dean, and VPI. It was noted that in the past LTI 1.1 allowed faculty to install tools at a strictly course-level. The new level LTI1.3 requires the tools to be installed at the account level. This means the tool is visible to all faculty who would have the ability to opt in or not. DOIT requested input on whether the process for implementation of a tool should change when a tool has AI features or whether the tool would follow the AI process. Discussion of the current process and the implications (including additional DOIT support needed and/or security issues) occurred. It was suggested that and LTIs with AI features be brought to Ed Tech as an information item, so they can be included in any report to DAS for informational purposes only. If any concerns are raised, then the original submitting faculty could be invited to address the concerns.

- Zero Textbook Costs – could a popup related to ZTC be installed so students can access the information easier? (Cardwell)
- LTI Canvas Integration with new Caption vendor (Mendell)
