Welcome & Announcements

The zoom meeting was called to order at 3:00pm. and the committee was welcomed by the faculty co-chair.

Approval of Agenda:

The agenda for the day was approved.

Discussion Item:

- OGS Survey Results – the AVC-IT presented information collected during the Spring 2025 semester related to the grading system which noted that the top concerns were: “Real-time student roster updates” (65%), “Access to DSPS Accommodation Letters” (49%) and “One-click add code sending and usage tracking” (48%). Overall, respondents frequently expressed a desire for more dynamic and accurate roster management, including better handling of student data, additions, withdrawals, waitlists, and permission numbers. Canvas integrations were seen as another way to improve grading processes and help provide up-to-date data. Next step is to interview a subset of survey respondents who indicated their willingness to participate to understand in finer detail how everyone uses the tool and what aspects they do/don't like.
- AssignLetterGrades LTI with AI component – as part of the new process adopted at the last meeting, the faculty member who submitted the Service Central Request (after going through their campus approval process) presented information on the

MyEssayFeedback tool. It was noted that DAS supports this tool which generates AI peer-review feedback for students and is currently limited to use as part of a three-year Research project but could be expanded by individual faculty opting-in. What type of rubric are we using to assess AI tools outside of FERPA, accessibility, etc., and should there be guidelines so that faculty do not rely on AI to review student's work?

- Other – during the OGS discussion, the CMS (Socrates) system lifespan was discussed. It was noted that the faculty who created Socrates is available only for two additional years for updates, so a replacement system needs to be researched. The AVCI noted that this topic will be on DCCC agenda.

Informational Updates:

- DOIT Update – AVC of IT noted: OGS enhancements discussed last week (including fraud indicators) were deployed along with communication related to their function. At a recent ISO meeting, the district's effort to block websites that are possibly sketchy was discussed including occasional temporary blocks to UC Davis and Wikipedia due to malicious code that another entity added to their website.
- AVCI Updates – Accessibility Capability Maturity Model has been approved by local and district senates. Los Rios will be visited by the CCC Accessibility Center team for training, assessment, and review the week of October 29-30, 2025. Gratitude expressed for all of those involved in the process. AVCI and the AVP of Workforce are exploring options to continue support of this program.
- CVC-OEI FastTrack – an update of the participants was provided.
- Library Update – it was noted that the one search/discovery system reverted to Shibboleth (from Okta) due to issues with some students no longer being in the active security group. Ideas for a better user interface for Papercut were also noted. AVCIT indicated he will discuss this with the Campus IT Supervisors at their next meeting.
- College Updates – each college provide updates on their activities.

- Zero Textbook Costs – could a popup related to ZTC be installed so students can access the information easier? (Cardwell)
- LTI Canvas Integration with new Caption vendor (Mendell)
- Notes in class schedule and how students need to click through them...Title 5 requirement – popup or checkbox to indicate they have read/reviewed the information. Submitted to IT Service Central in the past. (P.Bimbi)
- DSPS Idea – streamlining continuing updates
