Welcome & Announcements

The zoom meeting was called to order at 3:00p. and the committee was welcomed by the faculty co-chair.

Approval of Agenda & September Notes:

The agenda for the day was approved and the notes from the September meeting were reviewed & approved.

Discussion Item:

- MyEssay Feedback: DOIT clarified the LTI would be installed in such a way that a code is required to add a course for those participating in the research project.
- Canvas AI Grading – this is a grading assistance program, which is an optional tool in Canvas to be made available in Spring 2026. Some would like to pilot/use it, but others indicated hesitancy in turning this feature on/making it available. Student perspective is that it would be useful for 1st drafts of papers/projects, but AI generated grading seems too impersonal and would be something already available through ChatGPT but without privacy guardrails. It was noted that there are no regulations related to how much feedback (if any) is required to be provided to students. Research on other districts who have adopted this should be done and the ability for students to “opt out” should be available. This topic will be forwarded to DAS with a “proceed with caution” recommendation.

Informational Updates:

- DOIT Update – AVC of IT- they are reviewing how to use the WCET subscription and provided a DRAFT instruction guide.
- AVCI Updates – Accessibility Capability Maturity Model (ACCM) had a successful kickoff and there will be upcoming trainings.
- CVC-OEI FastTrack – an update of the participants was provided.
- Library Update – student printing options (including Papercut) and laptop needs were noted. The ability for students (and the district) to have electronic ID capabilities w/o the presence of tracking features was noted. DOIT was asked to research Gemini, which we may already have access to through CCCCCO.
- College Updates – each college provided updates on their activities. SCC introduced its student advisors. It was noted that the N2N pilot has ended with no plans to continue.
