Chair's Report

- Council continuation Council needs to discuss whether or not our council should continue beyond
 the spring. No decision has been made yet. Keith is hopeful that the committee will continue once
 the new hires come on board.
 - Our immediate goals such as evaluating existing course against area F requirements are complete.
 - Our long term goals are in progress
 - Evaluate proposed cross-listed courses to meet the CSU requirements, meeting
 DCCC and local curriculum committee timeline requirements
 - Create proposals for the future of ethnic studies programs, degrees, and courses in the district
 - Consultative body for ethnic studies discipline input on equivalency decisions for hiring
- SCC is creating an Ethnic Studies Department and Keith Heninburg will be chair of the department.
- No word yet on the Brown Act suspension. It will expire on September 30, 2021. Once expired, we
 will need to meet in a public location. Be prepared to change the location of your meeting
 participation.
