## PRISON AND REENTRY EDUCATION PROGRAM COMMITTEE (PREPC)

*Purpose:* To discuss and make recommendations on district-wide programs that interface with state and local correctional facilities and on-campus reentry services in support of SB 1391, AB 417, SB 416. The Committee addresses issues pertaining to instruction, professional development, student services, academic counseling, equity, technology and funding opportunities related to prison and reentry education (ex: SG-15). In addition, the PREPC supports Los Rios compliance with California Department of Corrections, Parole, Probation and Sheriff's Departments in serving incarcerated and formerly incarcerated students with appropriate communication and academic resources. The Committee is responsible for the coordination of prison education and reentry efforts directed by CCCCO.

**Reporting Structure:** Provides regular updates to the District Academic Senate on academic and professional matters. Committee members are expected to provide regular updates to their constituency groups and solicit input to advise the Committee as requested.
