Hot off the press! 2024-2025 FA Communication to Students	The priority deadline for submitting the 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act Application (CADAA) has been extended to May 2, 2024 (for the 2024-2025 award year only). If students have not submitted their 2024-2025 FAFSA or CADAA Application yet, please encourage them to do so ASAP. If they have received confirmation of a submitted 24-25 FAFSA from the Department of Education or confirmation of a submitted 24-25 CADAA from the California Student Aid Commission, then they do not have to complete it. Reminder: We expect to send communication to students in early May regarding 2024-2025 Financial Aid. This will all depend on the Department of Education and whether or not key technical issues have been resolved. We will continue to keep
