

1.0 Education and Career Goal

- 1.1 Each nonexempt student shall identify a specific education and career goal during the term after which the student completes fifteen (15) semester units of degree applicable credit course work.
 - 1.1.1 Each nonexempt student shall be given the opportunity to develop a student education plan describing the responsibilities of the student, the requirements the student must meet, and the courses, programs, and services required to achieve the stated goal.
 - 1.1.2 All nonexempt first-time students shall be required to identify a course of study, be assessed to determine appropriate course placement, complete orientation, and participate in counseling, advising, or education planning services.
 - 1.1.3 The student education plan shall be recorded in written or electronic form. The plan shall be reviewed as necessary to ensure that it continues to accurately reflect the needs and goals of the student.

2.0 Student Rights and Responsibilities

- 2.1 If a student fails to fulfill the responsibilities listed in the student education plan or fails to cooperate with the Los Rios Community College District in the development of an education plan within ninety (90) days after declaring a specific education goal, or fails to abide by his/her education plan, the District may suspend or terminate Student Success and Support Program (SSSP) services authorized. (Title 5, § 55530)

3.0 Due Process

- 3.1 A student may challenge any alleged violation of the provisions of the SSSP through the filing of a grievance. The Colleges shall investigate and attempt to resolve any such challenge in a timely manner. If the student alleges the application of an assessment test has the purpose or effect of subjecting any person to unlawful discrimination, then, upon the completion of the student grievance process, the College shall advise the student that he or she may file a formal complaint of unlawful discrimination.
